

Volcano Vista HS Approved Boundary

- On November 15th, the Board of Education approved boundaries for the new northwest high school, Volcano Vista HS
- Proposed Boundaries
 - North: The Bernalillo/Sandoval county lines from the Black Ranch area to a point 1 mile west of the extension of Universe Blvd; south along property lines to Irving Blvd; east on Irving Blvd to Universe Blvd; south on Universe Blvd to Paseo del Norte; south and east along Paseo del Norte and its extension to Coors Blvd.
 - South: Property lines between Westland Development Corporation and the City of Albuquerque from just west of the Shooting Range Access Rd; east along the city limits to its intersection with the escarpment; northeast along the escarpment to its intersection with Unser Blvd (south of Sipapu Av NW); south on Unser Blvd to its intersection with Atrisco Dr; south on Atrisco Dr to the intersection of Western Trail; east on Western Trail to Coors Blvd; north on Coors Blvd to Sevilla Av; east/south along property lines to the Corrales Drain and the Rio Grande.
 - East: From the intersection of Coors Blvd and Paseo del Norte; south on Coors Blvd to Montano Rd; east on Montano Rd to the Rio Grande; south along the river to the Corrales Drain.
 - West: A line along the west boundary of Black Ranch from the Bernalillo/Sandoval county lines to the City of Albuquerque property just west of the Shooting Range Access Rd.
- Timeline
 - New boundaries will take effect in the 2007/08 school year for 9th graders
 - New boundaries will take effect in the 2008/09 school year for 9th through 11th graders
 - New boundaries will take effect in the 2008/09 school year for 9th through 12th graders
 - The last school year for the Cibola/Del Norte Sister School Program will be 2007/08
