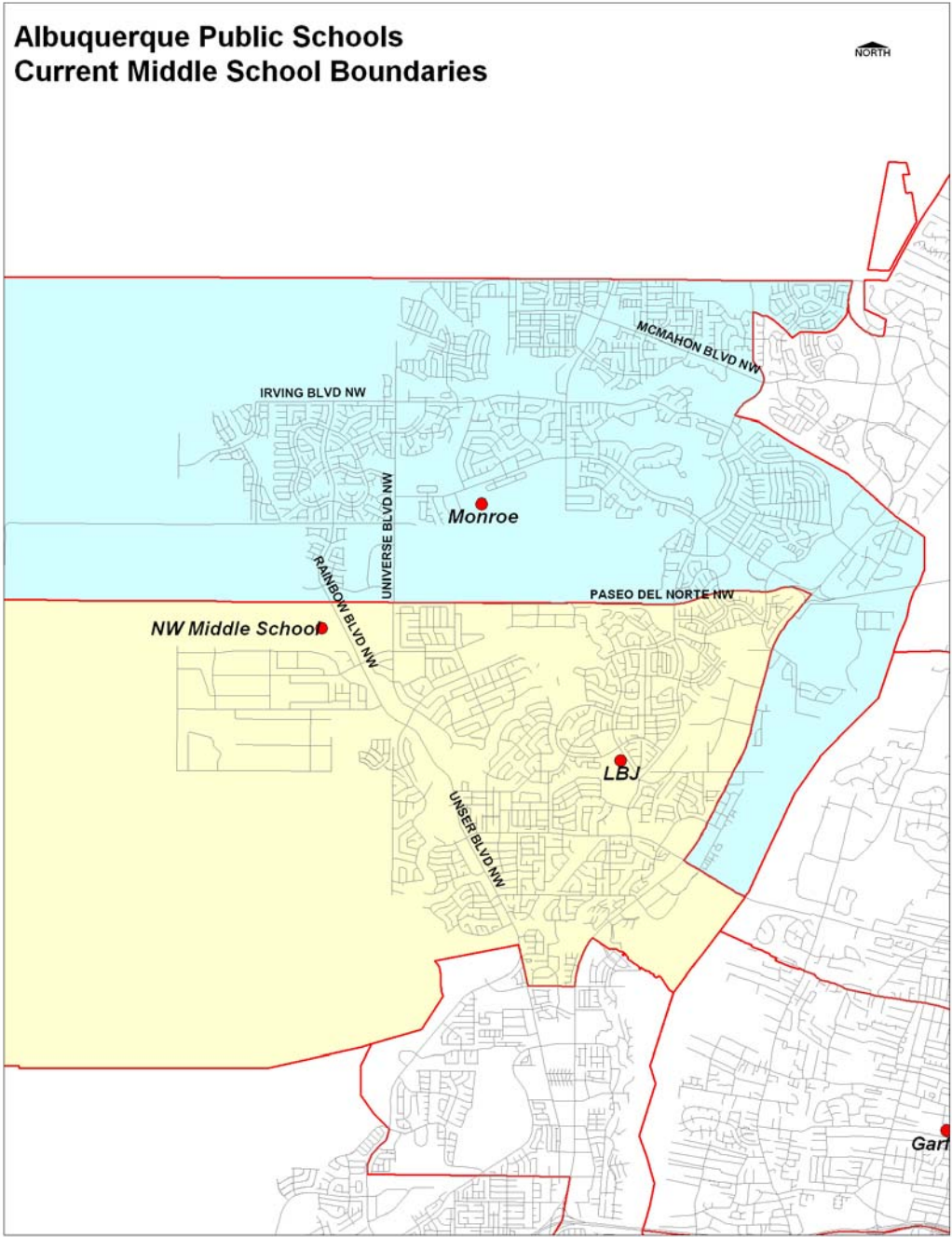

Albuquerque Public Schools Current Middle School Boundaries

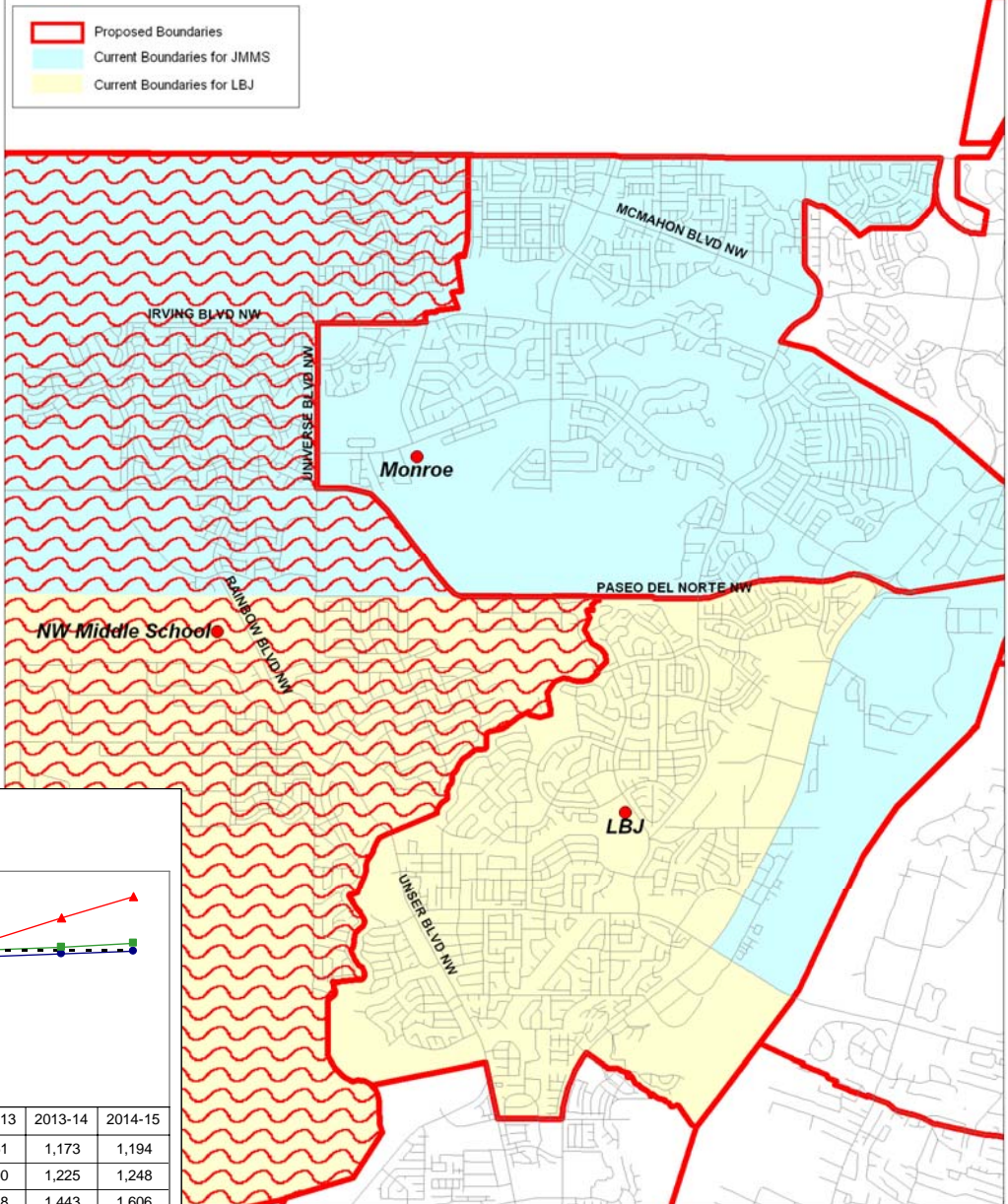


PROPOSED Northwest Middle School Attendance Areas

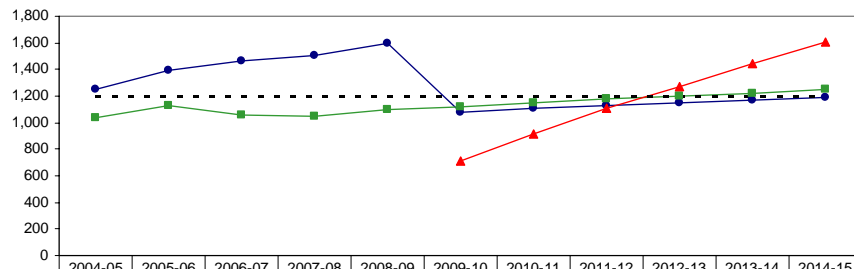
Pros

Summary of Public Input

Other Boundary Proposals

- Per proposed boundaries, Seville area would be assigned to NWES 2, new middle school, and Cibola. Students will not be moving with their peers. Make the area more of a pure feeder by assigning Seville to JMMS or Volcano Vista HS. APS should assign pure feeders.
- Per proposed boundaries, area NW of Irving and Universe would be assigned to NWES 1, new middle school, and Cibola. Move area to VRES and Volcano Vista HS. APS should assign pure feeders.
- Reassign an area of Seven Bar from Taylor to JMMS.

Other Comments

- Student stability is more important than a slightly bigger JMMS.
- Concerned that the new middle school will be overcrowded and students will be shuffled again.

Timeline

- October 11th First public meeting (Thurs, 7:00 – 8:30 pm, James Monroe MS)
- October 17th Second public meeting (Wed, 7:00 – 8:30 pm, James Monroe MS)
- October 23rd Boundary Committee will reconvene to consider the public comments and to determine if any adjustments need to be made to the proposed option.
- October 25th Proposal to Superintendent Dr. Beth Everitt
- November 6th Superintendent presents recommendation to the Capital Outlay Committee of the Board
- November 7th* Full Board of Education for adoption
- Aug 2009 New middle school opens

*There will be additional opportunities for public comments directly to the Board of Education on November 7th

**Parents of students in the affected boundaries will be notified and the new boundaries will be effective Fall 2009.
