

**NWMS Boundary Committee Meeting  
October 23, 2007**

**Minutes**

Under proposal, Seville goes to NWES 2, new middle school, and Cibola.

If a parent has children in both elementary and middle schools, then it would be more convenient if the Seville neighborhood went to NWES 2 and JMMS—not as convenient as it could be for parents who drive.

Parents probably wouldn't be going to the elementary and middle schools at the same time, due to bell schedules.

Chamiza and LBJ have similar bell schedules due to Chamiza being tiered at the middle school level, but the new elementary will be tiered at the elementary level.

Can't make everyone happy.

JMMS does not have a safe walk zone yet, otherwise, could free up to 15 busses.

136 current students plus continued growth makes moving the Seville area into JMMS infeasible.

**Motion: The committee understands the concern of the 136 students in Seville, but due to growth in the area north of Seville, it would not be practical to change the proposed boundaries.**

**3 out of 4 voting members approve the motion.**

**Recommendation to Board:** Proposed boundaries as is.
